All: And he said "Come."

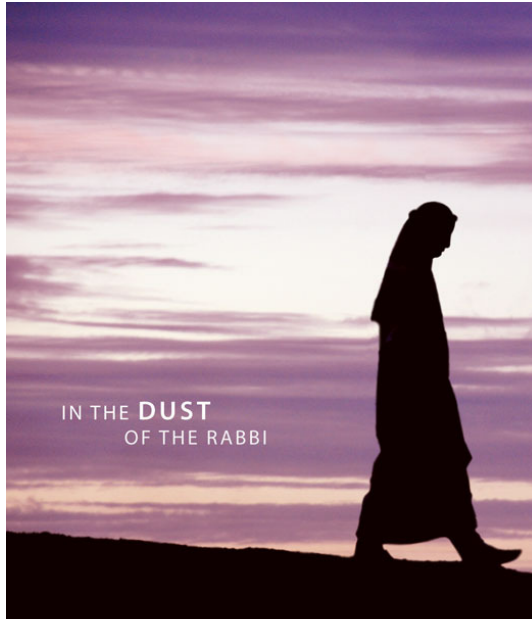
