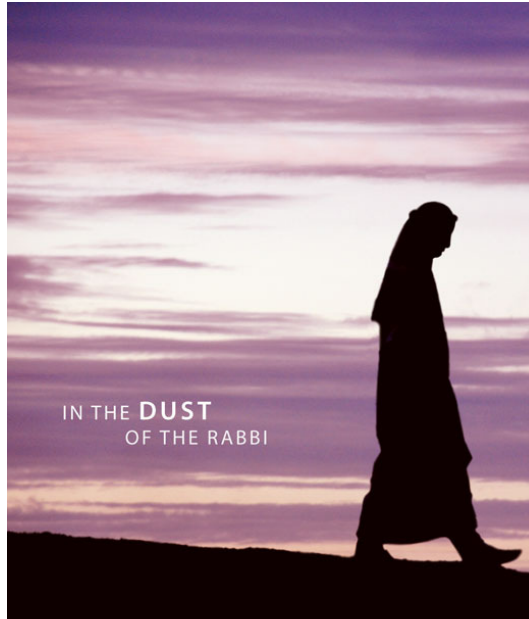
Pastoral Prayer
