Service of Communion Service of Communion in the United Methodist Church

In the United Methodist Church we practice open communion. You do not have to be a member of this church to participate in this service.

The act of communion is a tangible act remembering Christ’s sacrifice to redeem us from our sin through his sacrifice on the cross. By receiving these elements, it is a reminder of receiving Christ as Lord and Savior.

We serve communion by Intinction (Latin for “dipping in”). A piece of bread will be torn from the loaf and placed in your hands and then you take the bread and dip it into the cup and then receive the elements. If you are allergic to various breads, an alternative bread is also available in a bowl.

In light of concerns of the spread of a virus or disease, we find that that the use of intinction can be one of the best means of serving communion in a safe manner. In Intinction, the single server breaks off a piece of bread and offers it to recipients instead of many individuals placing their hands into a single container or plate of bread. Before the breaking of bread each server will cleanse their hands immediately before serving the elements to help provide the best protection against the potential

spread of any virus. Prayer has also been suggested by some as an additional help to address this problem.
