### Introducing Rev. Clyde Stanfield

Rev. Clyde Stanfield is a native of New Mexico, born in Grady. He attended Eastern New Mexico University, Perkins School of Theology, and the William Glasser Institute, studying with William Glasser, MD. He presently serves on the State Thanatopractice Board, appointed to that position by the Governor; also served eleven years on the Lovelace Institutional Review Board for Biomedical Research.
